## How to find colleges that are a good fit for you!

They ALL run money making events like – College Camps, Recruit Camps, Youth Camps, Private Instruction... Most of these are designed to help make money to pay for the assistant coaches.

We use this approach to find out what are the good college fits for YOU.

This form is designed to help us eliminate college programs that are NOT a good fit and therefore do not justify you spending time or money on their offerings.

Please answer the following questions as honestly as you can. Getting a good handle on this will help you focus your efforts.

1. What Level Can you PLAY at (sitting on the end of the bench will NOT help you get better)
2. What is your GPA/Test Scores & what do you want to Study
3. What geographical preferences do you have
4. What do the financials need to look like for a school to work for you

The answer to these 4 simple questions give us a good marketing plan for your promotion. As an example – if you want to study engineering – let's not market you or consider interest from schools that don't offer that degree program.

Also, please do some research on the cost of schools – In-state (for you) and out of state.

A 50% offer at an out-of-state D3 might sound great, but still leave you with \$25,000 to pay annually. Is this a good fit for you (as an example).
